The Basics

Mauritius does not have a strict dress code or official colour palette, but the island's luxury beach-resort culture naturally lends itself to a relaxed, elegant tropical style. Certain colours work especially well in the Mauritian setting, particularly at luxury resorts.

Light Neutrals

These are the most popular and practical colours for tropical resort wear:

White, Ivory, Beige, Sand, Stone, Taupe

These tones reflect heat well, feel sophisticated, and photograph beautifully against the turquoise ocean and tropical greenery.

Ocean & Tropical Tones

Inspired by the lagoon and island landscape:

Turquoise, Aqua, Sky blue, Navy, Teal, Sage green, Olive

These colours complement the coastal scenery and suit both daywear and evening resort attire.

Soft Pastels

Commonly worn for luxury island evenings:

Pale pink, Coral, Soft peach, Lavender, Light mint

These create an elegant tropical aesthetic without appearing overly formal.
